Safety Officer

Assume statutory Health and Safety Responsibilities for the Club.

Carry out necessary Risk Assessments on Club premises, practices and assets.

Ensure the serviceability of all Club Safety equipment.

Promote, encourage and develop the right safety culture amongst all Club members, any contractors and other personnel as appropriate.

Hold, and record all accidents in, the Accident Book. Report any accidents to the CPGA ASO.

Be responsible for compliance with relevant Food Hygiene Legislation.

In conjunction with one committee member make any final decision with regards to any safety matter affecting the Club or/and it's members in accordance with Club Safety rules.
