The Treasurer:

Is an Officer of the Club's management Committee (regularly liasing with the Chairperson & Secretary in particular)

Is a signatory on the Club's bank account, ensuring that signatories are always current & appropriate, to the satisfaction of the Committee.

Ensures that Club insurance payments are up to date.

Records & banks all income & records all expenditure, providing an annual statement of such. (Also producing a Treasurer's report as required for committee / club meeting)

Checks & keeps on file all bank statements.

Arranges cheque payments to external bodies as required. (ie CPGA membership, shipping fees, etc etc)

Records dates of all membership payments (for "Rowing Register")

Arranges auditing of accounts in time for Club AGM (November)

Encourages fundraising & local sponsorship
